MVP Health Care is Compliant with Provisions of the HITECH Act



The Health Information Technology for Economic and Clinical Health Act, or HITECH Act, was enacted recently as part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. The HITECH Act

imposes significant new obligations on entities covered under the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA). These new requirements include new notification requirements when a covered entity has a security breach.

MVP Health Care has reviewed these new regulatory obligations and developed a compliance strategy that addresses the HITECH Act requirements. This strategy includes processes for identifying, evaluating and reporting breaches as required by the new law.

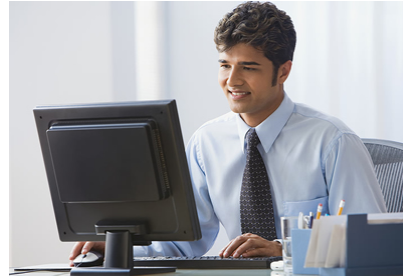
Protective head gear is required in order to participate in the clinic portion of the event. All boys MUST wear helmets and all girls MUST wear goggles.

This email will contain the effective date of your Broker of Record letter and the Sales Representative associated with the group will be copied as well.
